



PATHWAY TO A HEALTHY MARRIAGE

Couples who come to The Clearing may be in crisis for the first time, or suffer chronic conflict, or may be dealing with newly changed circumstances like an “empty nest” or retirement. Some of the issues may include things like:

Hopelessness. Long-standing conflicts that have never been resolved and seem impossible.

Infidelity. One or both of the partners have had extramarital affairs.

Lack of Affection. One or both of the partners have “fallen out of love” and believe they can never rekindle the flame. Boredom in the bedroom.

Escalating Anger. Inability to resolve conflicts without spiraling aggression.

Communication Difficulties. Not being able to say what one means and be understood.

Withdrawal. One partner pulls out of conversations, shutting the other down.

Pornography Addiction.

Different Convictions. Viewpoints on important issues that create recurring conflict.

Negativity. One partner berates the other consistently.

Four-day retreats offer a serene, sequestered environment, where two experienced marriage therapists help couples work through issues in a caring and effective way, reconciling problems and restoring hope again.

REMARKABLE RESULTS

For more than ten years, the Marriage Intensive Retreat has proven to be a highly effective format for couples in crisis to restore their relationship. Follow-up research indicates that nine of every ten couples stay married after participating, and they report marital satisfaction. 98% of the participants say they would recommend the Couples Intensives to a friend.

One of the key elements of success is the sustained work that couples do with two highly skilled, experienced marriage therapists over four days. Thirty hours of counseling allows the couples to go deep enough to get at the root issues causing problems in their relationship.

Another element of success is the fact that five couples are going through the process together. It's a small enough group to be personal, while allowing for conversations that are mutually helpful. The group dynamic fosters healing in a powerful way.

Once the Intensive is completed, each couple receives a detailed report and recommendations on what to do to continue the healing process and restore a fulfilling marriage.

ROOTED IN FAITH

The therapists for The Clearing approach marriage not as a contract but as a covenant, an eternal promise between a man, a woman, and God. The therapists have studied theology as well as psychology, and their approach is rooted in an understanding of both.

Participants of all faiths are welcome at The Clearing. Our therapists all come from a Christian background. Their job is to meet

participants where they are spiritually, whatever their faith, and show them the roadmap to move from a troubled marriage to the vibrant, lasting marriage they always hoped for.

When couples have completed the Marriage Intensive, they are referred to counselors or pastors in their faith community for follow-up. Catholic couples will have the opportunity for reconciliation or communion on site after the conclusion of the Marriage Intensive, if desired.
